## DENGUE AWARENESS RALLY

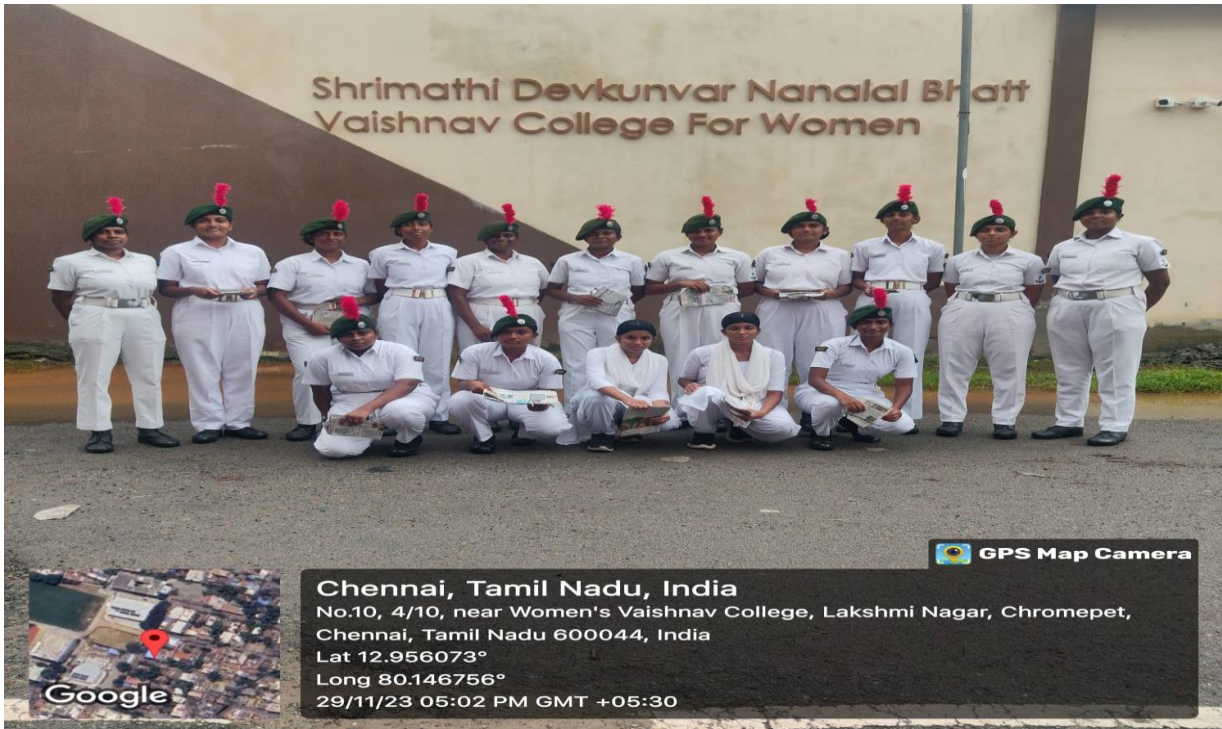
